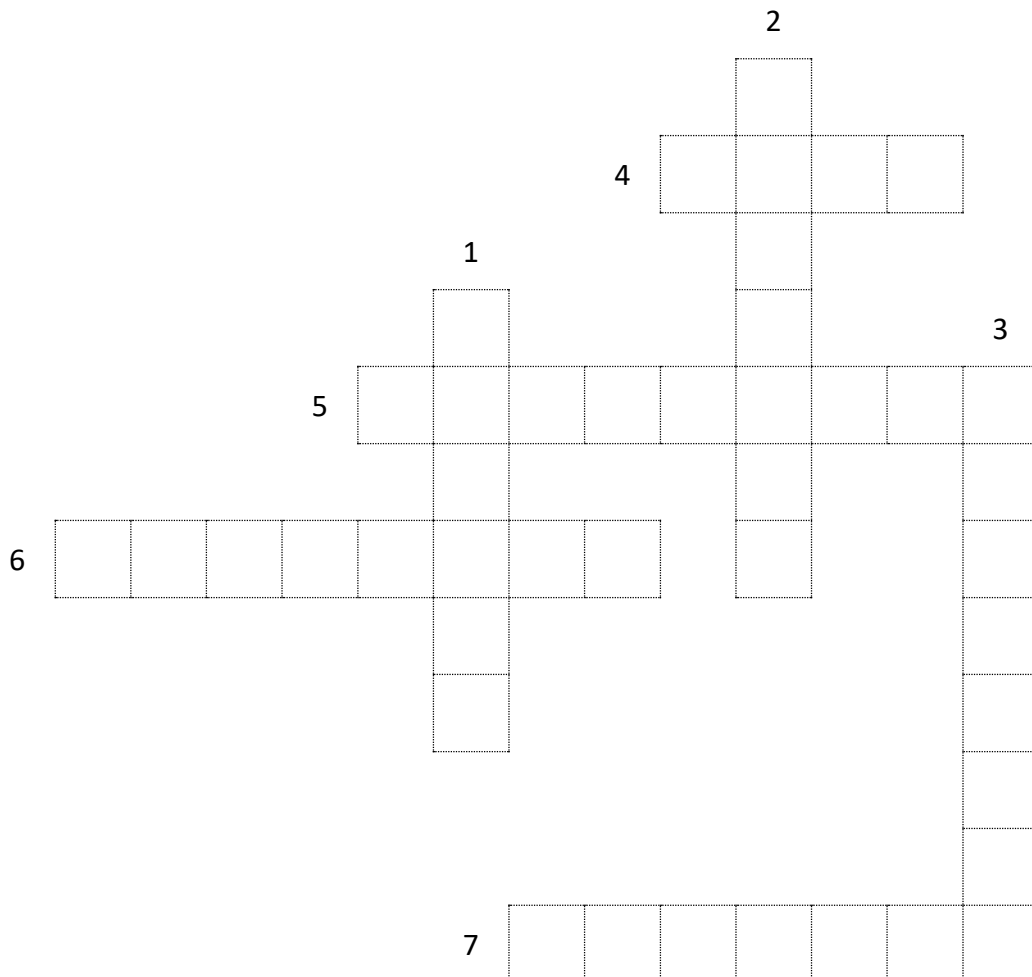


## Firma i jej struktura
